Title	Japanese(grammar)
Credit	no credits given / 180Hrs(=10,800min. = 90min.x 120classes, .)
Outline of Class	This class is for those who have no or little knowledge of Japanese. Japanese characters(Hiragana and Katakana) will be introduced at the beginning and students will learn basic vocabulary and grammatical structures of Japanese.
Aims	The aims of this class are 1) to provide students with a basic knowledge of Japanese Language, and 2) to acquire speaking and listening proficiency to carry out simple everyday conversation.
